

# Antiseptic

- CLEANS THE BLADDER AND KIDNEYS OF BACTERIA



**Active** ingredients: arbutin, chlorine, ellagic acid, ericolin, gallic acid, hydroquinone, malic acid, methyl-arbutin, myricetin, volatile oils, quercetin, tannins, ursolic acid, ursone and a substance similar to quercetin.

Most research has focused on Uva Ursi's urinary antiseptic component, arbutin, which typically composes 7% to 9% of the leaves. However, crude plant extracts are much more effective medicinally than isolated arbutin. Uva Ursi is reported to be a good diuretic and especially active against E. coli.

Uva Ursi is used as a diuretic, urinary antiseptic for bladder and kidney infections, hemorrhoids and womb problems (very good as a post-partum remedy to prevent infections). It strengthens the heart muscle and helps disorders of the spleen, liver, pancreas, and small intestines. It is good for female disorders.

**CAUTION:** Care must be taken to avoid excessive dosages of Uva Ursi; as little as 15 grams (1/2 an ounce) of the dried leaves has been shown to produce toxicity in susceptible individuals. Toxic signs include ringing in the ears, nausea, vomiting, sense of suffocation, shortness of breath, convulsions, delirium and collapse.

**Each vegetable capsule contains:**

Uva Ursi ..... .435 mg

Non-medicinal ingredients: Vegetable magnesium stearate and silicon dioxide, in a NON-GMO vegetable capsule composed of vegetable cellulose and purified water.

Contains no: Preservative, artificial flavour or colour, sugar, milk, starch, wheat, corn, soy or yeast.

**Suggested use:**

Take 1 or 2 capsules twice daily with meals, or as directed by your health care practitioner.
